As a consultant you will support families who have a child with a developmental delay, diagnosed disability or who are at-risk for a developmental delay as part of a home-visiting early intervention service. In collaboration with families, you will develop an individual plan which will encourage the child's development within the context of their daily routines and resources. Within a family-centred practice model you will assist families in acquiring information about infant/child development and community resources as it pertains to their infant/child and family. This service will be delivered as described in the Provincial Manual for Infant Development Programs.
