The Boom Man is responsible for safely and efficiently performing log booming, sorting, moving, securing, and handling operations using sidewinder and/or dozer boom boats. The position requires the employee to work both independently and as part of a marine crew while operating in and around log booms, booming grounds, shorelines, towing equipment, and other marine traffic. The Boom Man is expected to operate equipment in accordance with company procedures, the company's Safety Management System (SMS), applicable regulatory requirements, and the direction of the designated supervisor. Safety is the primary responsibility of the position. The Boom Man must recognize changing conditions, identify hazards, communicate effectively with the crew, and stop work when conditions are unsafe.
