Major Areas of Responsibility: • Complete Daily Pre Work Inspection before operating any equipment • Ensure that all equipment that is not functioning properly is reported on Daily Pre Work Inspection • Grease all equipment daily • Fuel all equipment daily • Clear tracks of debris daily • Check with supervisors, before work commences, that BC One Call has been notified, and all other utilities in the area have been contacted, and all services have been located • Read and understand all BC One Call information prior to digging • Meet with superintendent and foreman before job commences to discuss scope of work and site hazards • Have a thorough understanding of Stone Pacific Contracting Ltd. safety manual • Meet with foreman and crew every morning to discuss daily activities and safety concerns • Inspect equipment at the end of each shift to make sure cabs are locked, night switches are off and buckets are in appropriate place • Organize necessary attachments for the next days' work at the end of the previous shift • Ensure that all open excavations, manholes, and equipment are adequately delineated and barricaded at the end of each shift Work Environment: The following work environment characteristics are representative of the environment the job holder will encounter • Work outdoors in all season • Work around heavy equipment • Work near traffic • Exposure to loud noises • Work near overhead and underground utilities
