Job Profile

Job Summary:

The Building Maintenance Worker performs maintenance, upkeep on structures, grounds and equipment within the building, ensuring that it remains safe and functionable.

Job Duties:

1. Cleaning;

- Maintains floors on main level and shared use areas of residential floors this may include; vacuuming, washing, stripping, waxing, mopping and shampooing
- Collect and dispose of refuse in shared use areas
- Provides daily cleaning of bathrooms on the main floor
- Performs building cleaning as needed
- Cleans windows on main floor

2. Outdoor areas

- Maintains and cleans parking lot and sidewalks
- Maintains planted areas including: watering, weeding, plant maintenance, leaf removal
- Maintains outdoor sitting areas and children's play area
- Keeps outdoor areas clean of debris and hazards

3. Systems maintenance

- Performs preventative maintenance on equipment and systems such as heat, ventilation, plumbing and appliances
- Ensures all equipment is operating well

- Performs minor repairs to electrical, plumbing and mechanical equipment
- Maintains equipment maintenance logs

4. Building repairs and maintenance

- Prepares, paints and recovers interior and exterior building and other surfaces
- Carries out minor carpentry and other repairs and/or upgrades to furniture and buildings
- Maintains building maintenance logs
- Provide access and building orientation to contractors working in the building
- Vacant suite maintenance and touch ups in preparation for renting.

5. Tenant Relations

- Maintain a visible, professional presence with tenants to promote positive tenant relations.
- Respond to tenants requires and requests in a timely manner.
- Perform on call emergency maintenance and repairs as required

6. Other

- Arrange furniture for special events
- Performs unit inspections
- Maintains various logs as required
- Maintains janitorial and maintenance supplies
- Assist clients with minor maintenance as needed
