Requirements for Dockhand:

Excellent customer service skills.

Familiar with west coast saltwater fishing and marine operations.

Knowledge of fishing tackle.

Some cash handling experience.

PCOC (Pleasure Craft Operator's Card).

Duties for Fish Processor:

Read and fully understand DFO Area 25/125 fishing regulations, boundaries, and species, size, and quantity limits.

Fillet salmon, rock fish, ling cod, halibut, and other species as required and in accordance with food safety standards.

Vacuum pack and properly label filleted fish before freezing.

Clean and maintain the entire fish processing facility as scheduled or required and in accordance with food safety and sanitation standards.

Maintain a high level of organization in terms of guest information, fish tracking, arrivals and departures, and the facility itself.

Take payments and complete daily cash outs.

Duties of Dockhand:

Ensuring all rental boats have required safety equipment and read to go fishing gear.

Moving rental boats between fuel dock and parking slips.

Assisting guests with fueling and safety orientations.

Greeting guests and helping them carry personal belongings.
