Kwakiutl Band Council – Health is seeking a motivated and experienced Healthy Living Elders Coordinator to work at the Health Centre in Fort Rupert – just outside of Port Hardy, BC. Hours are 25 hours per week; salary to commensurate with experience. This is a one year term part-time position. The Healthy Living Elders' Coordinator works closely with the Health Team and others to promote holistic community health & wellness for our Elders and aging population. The focus is on preventative health strategies to promote the health and well-being of Elders and aging population within our community and to build relationships and connections with other Kwakiutl community members through a diverse range of programs: cultural, recreational, Elder development and education. Specific focus is also on promoting Kwakiutl language, culture and traditions with other community age populations.
