- Ensure all staff wear the proper safety gear while working beside the crane.
- report to the Net Service Manager on a daily basis to ensure no changes have been missed and that the wash site is not falling behind schedule.
- Complete Log Book daily.
- Perform daily visual inspections.
- Maintain equipment (grease, boom inspections, reporting issues)
- Offload incoming trucks.
- Ensure the proper bio-securities are being followed, and or in force proper methods
- Responsible for month-end paperwork
- Loading trucks with sludge and or other debris off-site.
- Follow all Company Policy and Procedures

- Complete all paperwork as required accurately including timesheets for payroll
