Community Support Worker – Supporting Adults with Developmental Disabilities

What you get:

- Tuition free training in a 13 week certification program
- Assistance to find and retain a job
- Supplemental short course training to support your employment goals
- Training and employment supports

You may be eligible if you are:

- Motivated to work and ready to commit to full time training
- Not employed and non-Employment Insurance (EI) eligible,* or
- Employed, but a low skilled individual,* or
- Employed, but underemployed*
- Living in British Columbia and legally entitled to work in Canada
- Not a student (i.e. enrolled in high school or post-secondary training)
- Not actively participating in another federal or provincially funded employment program
- Meeting the entrance requirements of the training program
- Note that a valid class 5 driver's license is required to work as a Community Support Worker

Space is limited, information sessions are scheduled for January 19th, 26th & February 2nd.
