Reporting to the Marine Maintenance Manager, the incumbent will plan and carry out inspections and maintenance of machinery and equipment on our salmon farms.

Responsibilities:

- · Perform inspections, maintenance and repairs on our salmon farming equipment.
- Engage and manage contractors as required. Provide oversight and scheduling.
- Ensure our 'Predictive and Preventive Maintenance' plan is carried out as intended by the Saltwater Maintenance Team.
- Read and interpret drawings, blueprints, electrical code specifications and schematics in order to effectively troubleshoot, maintain and repair equipment.
- Optimize equipment safety and efficiency by participating in continuous improvement projects and completing work orders according to PM schedules.
- · Work on other projects as required.
- Be self-starting and able to deal with a wide range of people in all levels of the building/sub-contracting industry.
- · Work with other trades and contractors in a flexible team environment to achieve greater efficiencies and productivity.
- Assist the production team in the efficient operation of the equipment.
- Work safely and ensure safety of staff and of outside contractors working on site as per Marine Harvest Canada
