








WOMEN'S OUTREACH WORKER (.75FTE)

Our Counsellor/Outreach Worker assists women in a variety of ways, including the planning & facilitating of workshops, developing strong links with other service providers and resources and providing counselling to women who are experiencing or have experienced violence in their lives.

We expect that you will have at least a post-secondary degree in counselling, social work or related field and 2 years' experience. An equivalent combination or education and work experience will be considered.

PEACE COUNSELLOR (.6FTE)



Working with children who have witnessed abuse or violence in the home requires a special person.

You will provide individual counselling, crisis intervention, as well as support groups for children between the ages of 5 and 18. A post–secondary degree and 2 years related experience is suggested, although other combinations of education and experience will be considered.
